A man builds forms with "slow motion material ", an unique material which disintegrates in slow motion under the worried glance from a camera.

The slowmotion material is an original material made of micro steel balls, a special glue added to the balls slow the movement of each balls. The first version of the material have been acheived in 1997 , and have been develloped more further in 2008 . A software ( encoded by Yacine sebti ) display differents points of view of the material using a single video camera .
